## (Being) Catholic Matters

David Lins, Director of Faith Formation

During Lent, Catholics are told we need to pray, fast and give alms. Why?

Yes. Prayer helps us grow closer to God. Fasting helps us recognize our need for God. Giving to others helps us recognize the blessings we have received from God and pass that blessing along to others.

Fine. Great. ...but there needs to be more. ...and there is!

At the start of Luke 4, the devil tempts Jesus. He begins by tempting Jesus, who had been fasting for weeks, to turn stones into bread. Then, he offers Jesus every kingdom of the world if Jesus would only bow before him. Finally, he tells Jesus to throw himself down from the highest point of the temple, only to be saved, thus revealing His identity as the Son of God.

These temptations are the same temptations that broke Adam and Eve! Genesis 3:6 says, "When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food (pleasure) and pleasing to the eye (possessions), and also desirable for gaining wisdom (pride), she took some and ate it."

What is the antidote to the desire for pleasure? Fasting.

What is the antidote to the desire for possessions? Giving.

What is the antidote to pride? Prayer.

This is the reason that WE MUST fast, give, and pray!

(Why do you think religious take vows of chastity, poverty, and obedience? To combat temptations to pleasure, possessions, and pride!)

If we truly want this Lent to be special, the formula is simple: fast without grumbling, give something that hurts to part with, and pray more than you have in the past.

And give your Lenten journey a kick start by joining us in the church this Monday and Tuesday from 6:30-7:30PM for our Lenten Parish Mission with Mr. Steve Pokorny.

His goal is to help you go from wherever you are in your faith walk to the next level!

There isn't much in the world more important than that!

### Sacrament of Matrimony

A comprehensive nine-month preparation program is required by the Phoenix Diocese to assist couples who are called by God to the Sacrament of Matrimony. Prayerful preparation, discernment, discussion and learning about oneself and one another is integral and essential to the process.

After an initial meeting with one of the parish priests, wedding dates are chosen. To begin the marriage preparation process, call the Parish Office at (480) 488-2229.

### Anointing of the Sick

The Sacrament of Anointing is celebrated to bring spiritual and even physical strength during an illness or especially near the time of death. The sacrament conveys graces and strengthens against discouragement, anxiety, temptation and conveys peace and fortitude. As soon as one feels the effect of age, illness or the nearness of death, the time for the sacrament has arrived. Call the parish office (480) 488-2229 to schedule a priest to visit.

Only Catholics who are not conscious of grave sin and have fasted for one hour from solid food may receive Holy Communion. Catholics who need to take medicine with food are not obligated by the ordinary norm.
