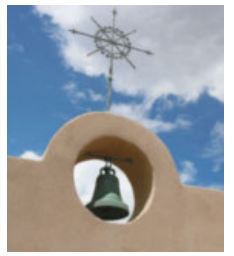

A MESSAGE FROM FR. CLEMENT Parochial Vicar

THE HARD CHOICES

We are almost halfway through Lent. For some of us, the journey has been fruitful, yet for some others it has been a real challenge. The recognition that we often take two steps forward and one step backward can be discouraging. We are at the point where we are questioning our own sincerity. The fact is that we must repeat and renew our choices over and over again.

Lent is a time of choosing. It is a time to choose to press on, no matter what. In a special way, Lent is a time to make some hard choices too. Life is tough sometimes, and tough times demand tough choices. Maybe this is the time to make that tough choice to stay away from the near occasion of sin. A time to do those things we need to do to fight against our addiction. A time to break off a toxic or harmful relationship. A time to show some tough love to any of our kids who is not responding to our guidance. A time to restrain the desire to gamble. A time to learn how to say I'm sorry when I'm wrong. A time to forgive that person who hurt you so badly.

What is that hard choice the Lord is inviting you to make? What is preventing you from doing so? Is it fear? Is it shame? Is it pride? Or is it because of the pleasure I enjoy from that habit? The thing is, you know very well how your decision not to make that hard choice is ripping you off, how it is affecting your life, your marriage, your health, your job, your relationship with your kids, and even your relationship with God.

Is the decision not to make that hard choice worth losing your life, your marriage, your job, your health, your family, your peace? Tough times demand tough choices. Think about it.

May the Lord help us to see those places in our lives where we need to make those hard choices and give us the grace and courage to do so. Amen!

Lent is an important time. It is about more than giving something up. It is a time to say no to ourselves, and to say "God, I love you more than __ (fill in the blank) ____". It is a time to regularly reflect upon making God #1.

Fasting is a great way to spiritually discipline ourselves and learn to tame the disordered appetites we acquired from the stain of original sin. Not just food, but money, lust, gossip, negative thinking, finding fault with others, spiritual sloth, pride and so on.

If it is medically impossible to fast from food, there is no shortage of other things to fast from. What sin are you struggling with the most? Do you gossip? Do you take a negative approach? Are you preoccupied with what to buy next? Is there someone you need to forgive?

Instead of shopping, give alms; for example, there is a wooden box on the wall in the back of the church for cash donations for St. Vincent DePaul. Easy!

Instead of lack of forgiveness and bitterness, forgive everyone all day long (everyone deserves countless do-overs so give them, expecting none in return).

Instead of gossip, go out of your way to compliment someone. Walk away from those who choose to gossip.

Instead of pride, adopt humility. See yourself as a servant and helper to all you encounter each day. Talk less and ask others about themselves, and then really listen.

Instead of lust, lower your eyes. See everyone as family (because they are).

Instead of spiritual sloth, do more than attend mass. Increase your spirituality. Commit to saying the rosary each day without fail. Spend at least 30 minutes in adoration. Read scripture.

So, there are options besides fasting from food, and many more than what are listed here. By committing to new behaviors, we can truly change and replace ourselves with Jesus. In the end, we want our Father in Heaven to see his beloved Son when he looks upon each of us. Right?



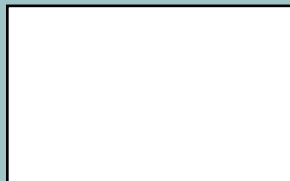
