

DO NOT LET YOUR HEARTS BE TROUBLED

Jesus said that exaggerated anxiety and discouragement are the 2 greatest obstacles to holiness. He said anxiety is the fruit of self love. How could anxiety possibly be "self love"? We think of self love as vanity; looking in the mirror and admiring ourselves, holding ourselves in high regard or being impressed with ourselves. But self love can manifest itself in other ways. When we are anxious, we are not so much worried about how things will turn out, but how we will deal with it when it does. Will I be humiliated? Will I know how to handle the outcome? What will I do? This may not sound like self "love", but actually any focus on "self" is self love, whether it is admiration or worry. The final consequence of self love, or anxiety, is lack of trust in Jesus, his omnipotence and divine providence.

If this sounds like you, (and it actually sounds like most of us), ask Him for the grace to trust Him more. When the temptation to worry creeps up, focus on Him, not the storm.

Say, "Jesus, I put it in your hands." Then be still. He is right next to you waiting for you to do it.

He said that the vessel by which we access his mercy is trust. He wishes to lavish souls that trust in him with overflowing graces. Trust in Him is the opposite of anxiety.

PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY

Prayer Shawls are given to people in need of prayers and comfort owing to illness, grief and stress. We also make Prayer Shawls to celebrate a variety of life events, such as births, baptisms, marriages and birthdays. We pray on our shawls as we are making them and, when a shawl is finished, the group gathers around and offers prayers for the recipient.






