

(BEING) CATHOLIC MATTERS

You've heard this Sunday's Gospel before, but have you paid attention?

In the parable, we meet the worst gardener in the whole wide world. He's throwing seeds on the path. He's tossing seeds into the rocks. He's sprinkling seeds into the thornbushes. And it is almost as if he gets lucky and hits a patch of fertile super-soil.

Then, he says the most curious thing of all: "Whoever has ears ought to hear."

This line tells us that not everyone is going to get this one. And this makes sense, given the subject matter.

The Lord gives the opportunity for eternal life to every single one of us.

Some of us are hardened and want no part of his forgiveness, grace, and love. Others among us believe, but our faith is shallow and cannot sustain hardship. Still others allow our faith to be choked out by the burdens of this life. Finally, there are those among us who till our spiritual soil with personal prayer, reading our Bibles, and lives soaked in the sacraments. Those who do this, have souls where God's grace can multiple and have an impact for generations.

But that isn't the whole story.

Those among us who till our spiritual soil with personal prayer, reading our Bibles, and lives soaked in the sacraments, "have the ears to hear."

They read the Bible and begin to understand deeper levels of meaning. Homilies resonate and have the power to have lasting impact. Wisdom comes to them from out of nowhere... except they know precisely where it comes from.

May we all till the soil of our souls so that we may be wise in Christ, understand a bit more of our Lord, and increase our desire to dive into our Faith all the deeper.

Then—and only then—will we produce fruit for the Lord, a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold.

Welcome to Our Lady's Corner– Your Source for Catholic Inspiration!

So Jesus said to them," Truly, Truly I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you." John 6:53

A true Eucharistic Miracle takes place at every mass, when the priest utters the words of consecration. At God's choosing, it is visible. In 1996 in Argentina, a parish priest was told that a consecrated host was desecrated in the back of the church and was not able to be consumed. When this happens, since the host is consecrated, the usual method is to place it in water, then place the glass of water into the tabernacle to dissolve, which it was. Several days later when the tabernacle was opened, the host transformed into a piece of bloody tissue, larger than the original host. This was not publicized, but kept in the tabernacle. Several years later, the transformed host, had not changed at all. No attempt had been made to preserve it in the first place. Dr. Ricardo Castanon Gomez, a neuroscientist, took a sample and sent it to New York, keeping its source unrevealed. 5 Scientists, including Dr. Frederick Zugibe, a renowned forensic pathologist testified that the material was a fragment of human heart muscle from the left ventricle in an inflammatory condition with many white blood cells, indicating that the heart was alive when the sample was taken and the owner was "severely beaten about the chest." Blood type was AB, the universal receiver, which is the blood type of all miracle hosts as well as the Shroud of Turin. All humans have either chromosomes XX (girl) or XY (boy). The host had only an X! The X always comes from the mother! There was no Y chromosome!

When you receive Holy Communion, you are receiving Jesus' beating heart. There is no doubt about it. How badly must he want to unite with you? How very much are you beloved? The Eucharist is the greatest expression of his love for you. Receive your king with extreme reverence every time, and as often as possible. All of your power comes from Holy Communion, the power to love and forgive like Jesus.

PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY

Prayer Shawls are given to people in need of prayers and comfort owing to illness, grief and stress. We also make Prayer Shawls to celebrate a variety of life events, such as births, baptisms, marriages and birthdays. We pray on our shawls as we are making them and, when a shawl is finished, the group gathers around and offers prayers for the recipient.

We meet on the last Friday of each month from 10 AM to Noon in the Parish Hall.
