

A MESSAGE FROM FR. PARKS

The Intolerance of Tolerance

I love the Olympics. So, I tuned into the Opening ceremony of the Olympics to watch athletes around the world represent their respective cultures. It is also a time for the host country to present itself to the world, for France to put its best foot forward showcasing its culture and people. In the midst of these festivities, those in charge of the event thought it would be appropriate to have Da Vinci's portrayal of Jesus' last supper be reenacted by a group of drag queens in a sexually charged performance. It was awful, and weird, that someone thought this would be a good thing to include.

There has been a number of voices expressing outrage by the performance. Subsequently, the Paris Olympic Committee said it was not meant to mock the last supper but was about a feast meant to celebrate the Greek god Dionysius... well, color me skeptical. With that claim, they issued an apology which in part said, "Clearly there was never any intention to show disrespect to any religious group. On the contrary... we really did try to celebrate community tolerance... if people have taken any offense, we are, of course, really, really sorry." I want to take notice of two things, first, this is not an apology. It is what so many modern people do, there is no real admission of any wrongdoing, (e.g. "That was wrong, should not have been done, and we apologize for it.") But rather, if you "took offense" then we are sorry about that. Well, the reason why people can take offense at things, is because they experienced something offensive. Thus, their response is perfectly justified considering the situation. I would rank this event with that sentiment.

Secondly, they clearly say this was meant to be a a celebration of "community tolerance". What is interesting, is that everyone appears to be tolerated except for the 2.6 billion Christians in the world whose faith was mocked. Apparently, tolerance does not include them (or should I say "us") as a category. This so often happens in modern times, where the last acceptable prejudice appears to be anti-Catholics specifically, and anti-Christian generally. This is the intolerance of tolerance. So often when tolerance is being evoked, it can be an implicit or outright attack on the Christian faith. We should stick up for ourselves when this happens, and claim our own right to be tolerated. Be on the look out for this canard in modern times, when "tolerance" is being evoked, is it really tolerance—or just a front for an anti-Christian attack?

Welcome to Our Lady's Corner— Your Source for Catholic Inspiration!

The National Eucharistic Congress recently took place in Indianapolis. Just a few weeks ago, Catholics young and old gathered for five days of talks, presentations, Mass, adoration and a Eucharistic procession through the streets of the city. It was very public and very moving. The Holy Spirit was very present and will use this to sweep the nation with His love, peace and wisdom.

No sooner did the Congress commence, Satan attempted to strike back with a blasphemous mocking of the last supper at the Opening ceremonies of the Paris Olympics. Most of you have heard about this.

Take heart. We know Mary will crush the head of the serpent. We know that Jesus will not be defeated.

"Let nothing trouble you. Let nothing frighten you. All things are passing away: God never changes. Patience obtains all things. Whoever has God lacks nothing. God alone is enough."

We must ask the Holy Spirit for guidance in all things. We must sit with Him in silence. We must not act on our first response, but take a moment, and then respond with love. With peace and love, we must live our faith daily. We must not stop praying at abortion clinics, participating in the political process, volunteering, speaking up, being charitable to all. We must increase mass participation (say each word with meaning, not "space out", actively play your role as part of the faithful, arrive in plenty of time, not leave early). We must increase daily mass attendance as much as possible. We must increase Eucharistic adoration.

This is no time to be spiritually sedentary. The Holy Spirit can do little without the cooperation of God's Children. He can do all things, but prefers to do His work THROUGH US. What happens if we just sit here? What will happen to the kingdom? Will you allow yourself to be left out?

Mary's "yes" is a guiding example. Imitate Her fiat and serve under her standard. Do not react to the world with hate, but with gentleness. Actively participate in the kingdom today.
