

A MESSAGE FROM FR. PARKS

The Building Block of Society

We live in interesting times. A time when it appears that everything has been politicized. There are forces in our culture that think the foundation of our culture should be the government. This is most clearly shown by those who advocate for socialism (or communism) and think that the means of production—the factories, the companies, the machines, etc. that produce the goods and services of our economy—should reside primarily (or exclusively) in the hands of government bureaucrats. Against this push for government being the foundation of our society are those who advocate for individual rights (rights to speech, religion, property, etc.) to have that fundamental role. Although we certainly need some government intervention in our life and economy, and we certainly should protect individual rights—neither is an adequate foundation for culture. The building block of society is the family.

Notice what the Catechism of the Catholic Church says about the family:

"The family is the original cell of social life. It is the natural society in which husband and wife are called to give themselves in love and in the gift of life. Authority, stability, and a life of relationships within the family constitute the foundations for freedom, security, and fraternity within society. the family is the community in which, from childhood, one can learn moral values, begin to honor God, and make good use of freedom. Family life is an initiation into life in society (CCC 2207)."

Nothing is more formative for a human person than the family they were raised in. The CCC says the family is the foundation for, "freedom, security, and fraternity within society." Following the adage, "an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of the cure" we will be fundamentally better as a culture if we tend to promote and protect the dignity and role of the family—the preventative "cure" to so many societal ills. It has been widely documented in social studies that the greatest "privilege" to have in life is "two parent privilege." As it turns out, God's plan is true and good.

The CCC goes on to say that the family is a "pre-political" reality that a just government simply recognizes and defends. For our part, we should be on the lookout for legislation or cultural movements that undermine the authority and goodness of the family while also being committed to our own family—that we would play our part in building up the goodness, unity, and faithfulness of those God has willed for us to walk with in this life.

WHY VOTE NO ON PROPOSITION 139

- 1) Any medical profession can perform an abortion, this includes a chiropractor or nurse assistant, etc.
- 2) A minor should be able to have an abortion without parental consent or knowledge. A child sex trafficker, pimp or abuser can bring a child in to have an abortion and allow the sex imprisonment of a child to continue unreported. Also, parents have no rights.
- 3) Up until birth, a women can obtain an abortion:
- The mother is given pills over 24-48 hours to induce labor.
- The abortionist begins to dismember the child in the womb, limb by limb, crushing and removing the head, and finally the abdomen. The child is reassembled on a tray to be sure that all pieces have been removed.
- Also, the medication digoxin can be injected into the womb via the mother's abdomen to cause the child's heart to stop beating.
- If a heartbeat is detected the next day, the medication is re-injected, but this time, directly into the baby's heart
- 4) There is no need to offer adoption as an option.
- 5) The Planned Parenthood "medical professional" evaluates and indicates on a checklist that they intend to use dismemberment in the procedure (fact).
- 6) A mother with mental health issues can be deemed unfit by a "medical professional" and encouraged to abort their child.
- 7) A child who survives an abortion should be left unattended and untreated, and upon his/her death, discarded.

If Prop 139 is voted in, ALL of the above will be in the state constitution, and nearly impossible to ever change. Did you know ALL of those things? Go back and re-read.

"I would never do it, but what someone else does is not my business" indicates that you sanction this, that you think it is ok that it happens. Where will it end? How will God respond to our country? To our state? To you? We will all have to give an account of our life upon our death. How will anyone explain this? How will you look Christ in the eye and explain a "yes" vote? This is not a scare tactic, but an actuality. It is time to live as a Catholic intentionally. Vote NO.






