A MESSAGE FROM FR. PARKS

Why Tithe?

With our readings this week focusing on two widows giving to provide for the need of a prophet (or the temple), it naturally raises questions about the practice of tithing. Are Catholics obliged to tithe? If so, how much? And, how should we think about tithing?

Although tithing is traditionally understood to give 10% of your gross income (5% percent to your local parish, and 5% to charitable causes) the Church does not specify how much —or what percentage — a person should give to the Church. The Code of Canon Law (which governs the Church) says the following:

The Christian faithful are obliged to assist with the needs of the Church so that the Church has what is necessary for divine worship, for the works of the apostolate and of charity, and for the decent support of ministers. (Canon Law 222)

So, to put it more simply, one of the precepts of the Church is that Catholics are to help provide for the needs of the Church. As far as how much? Well, that is a discernment of each individual and family.

To the question of why, let's look at 2 Corinthians 9:5-8:

So I thought it necessary to encourage the brothers to go on ahead to you and arrange in advance for your promised gift [donation], so that in this way it might be ready as a bountiful gift and not as an exaction. Consider this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. Each must do as already determined without sadness or compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. Moreover, God is able to make every grace abundant for you, so that in all things, always having all you need, you may have an abundance for every good work.

Paul is saying that the tithe/gift/donation cannot be exacted from a person, or then it would cease to be a gift! But attached to tithing is a promise from God—that He is not outdone in generosity and that those "who sow bountifully will reap bountifully". Thus, tithing is an act of worship, of sacrifice, of love and trust. It takes faith to tithe. To believe that God will take care us even when we give to the Church and the needy.

Lastly, the Lord "loves a cheerful giver." Are we generous people? In how we give our time, talent, and treasure in serving and loving the Church and others? That is the ultimate question that the question of tithing should make us address.

Welcome to Our Lady's Corner— Your Source for Catholic Inspiration!

The Holy road map for the Saints is the beatitudes. They are not for the faint of heart or the lukewarm, but they are a spiritual guide given to us by our High Priest, Jesus Christ.

The second beatitude is, "Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted." Saints are in a constant state of awareness of their sins, and they have constant holy mourning for them. Consider the gospels. They were written by the apostles who said and did spiritually immature things prior to the coming of the Holy Spirit in the upper room. It took great humility to place these things in their own gospels. They were keenly aware of their mistakes and sins. Imagine Peter including his thrice denial of Jesus while they were questioning and beating Jesus, then hearing the cock crow and running away in tears and great shame. What tremendous humility to include them in the gospel where this would live and be told for all ages. It truly requires humility to honestly see the gravity of our sins as the apostles did.

Holy sorrow for our sins means that our conscience is working. When your conscience is working, you will be compelled to acknowledge your offences against God and diligently work to change.

Holy mourning also gives us insight regarding the evils of this world, and the ability to have holy sorrow as you see the many evils around us. We are told not to judge, and it is true that we cannot judge another's heart, but as Christians, our first approach must be to despise all that our Lord taught was objectively morally evil. And when we encounter another's immoral lifestyles, the appropriate response must be holy sorrow. To mourn over another's choice is a true act of charity toward them.

Holy sorrow does not mean that we despair. It is a sorrowful recognition of our and others offenses toward God. To be constantly aware of our state of sinfulness is an act of humility, and will help us to be "little" in God's presence as we affirm that we will correct our ways, go to confession frequently, and always seek to put God and others first as we keep our eyes fixed on Heaven. Holy sorrow is a true virtue.


