

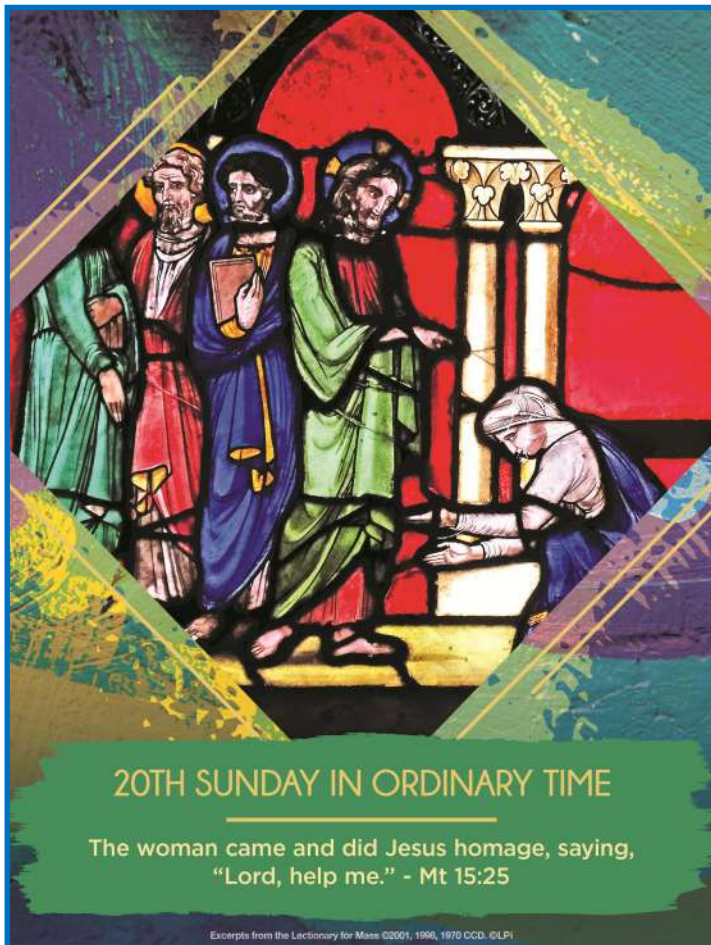

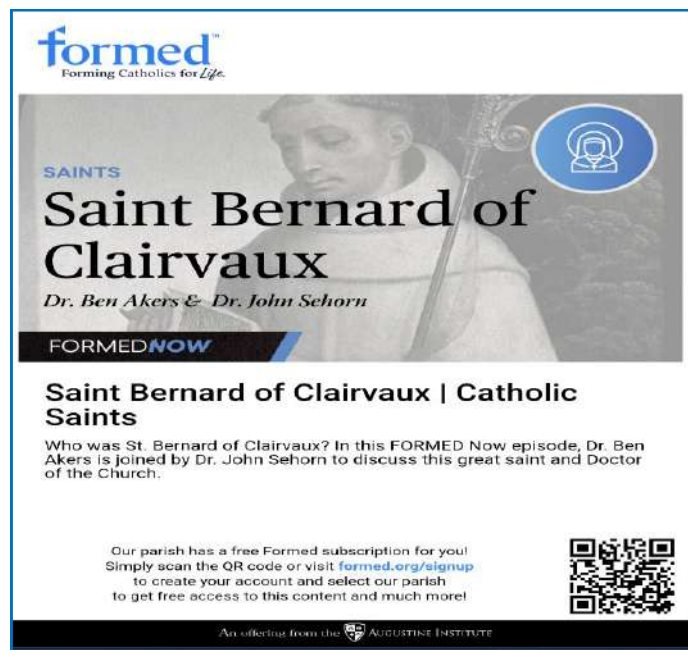

WHAT'S ON FORMED NOW?

Bernard was born in 1090 into a wealthy noble family in Burgundy, France. He had everything the world could offer - status, education, opportunity - but his heart was set on something greater. At age 22, Bernard entered the newly founded Cistercian Order, a branch of the Benedictines focused on simplicity, silence, and prayer. When he joined, he brought 30 friends and family members with him - a remarkable act of evangelization.

Bernard was declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Pius VIII in 1830 was extolled as Doctor *Mellifuus* - Latin for "doctor full of honey" - in an encyclical by Pope Pius XII. He is reckoned as the last of the Church Fathers and his Feast Day August 20th. Learn more about St. Bernard of Clairvaux by watching this episode on Formed Now.

A MESSAGE FROM FR. JESS

Dear Family of God,

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus' seemingly harsh treatment to a Canaanite woman in the end brought out the best in her. She was determined no matter what and she got what she asked for. Jesus said of her: *"O Woman great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish."* And the woman's daughter was healed from that hour.

Brothers and sisters, the past experiences of trial and sufferings are a test of our faith too. We need to persevere in deepening our faith and knowledge of our God. But before all this happens, this deepening in our knowledge and faith in God, we have to deepen our knowledge of ourselves by saying, "Who am I in front of God?"

Do I take God's discipline as punishment or as something necessary for growth? Does God's seemingly delay of answering my prayers mean he is not listening, or is he letting me grow more in my desire of union with him, or grow my trust in him? If I am in that woman's shoes, will I persevere like her, or easily give up at first encounter of resistance? Can I be humble like her and just go away protecting my ego?

Being a Christian is not for weaklings. To follow Jesus involves great sacrifices such as denying ourselves, and taking up our cross and following Jesus' example of doing always the will of the Father and not his own will. As Saint Maximilian said, "Obedience is the only way to give Glory to God." Doing the Father's will is the highest priority of Jesus, it must be ours too.

May Our Lady of Joy, like her Son, always be willing to do God's will and help us all.

Welcome to Our Lady's Corner— Your Source for Catholic Inspiration



August is the month of the Immaculate Heart of Mary and this weekend, we celebrate the feast of her Assumption.

It is important to make the distinction between Jesus' ascension and Mary's assumption. Jesus ascended by His own power, whereas Mary was assumed into heaven by the power of God. What is important to know about Mary's assumption?

In Mary, we see the final triumph of God over evil, and in her assumption, the final promise of the resurrection of the body. We believe that her entire body, perfect without sin, was taken to heaven. She was brought to the fullness of God in the trinity. When we die, we are spirits only. But at the end of all time, the final judgement, we are reunited with our bodies. When Mary's entire body and soul was assumed, she achieved this fullness. This gives us hope! This is possible for us!

There is a misunderstanding with our protestant brothers and sisters. They believe that we worship Mary. Indeed, we do not. She is our greatest intercessor and is very close with Jesus. She knows how to bring you right to Him. Jesus loved and honored His mother, and so we, too, love and honor her. We only worship God in the 3 persons of the Holy Trinity, and Mary wouldn't have it any other way.

Mary has been described as God's masterpiece, and rightfully so.

John was your stand-in at the foot of the cross when Jesus said, "Son, behold your mother." Jesus values family and gave you a mother who loves you with the most gentle and big love any mother could ever have. You are hers, and her will is aligned with God's will. She protects you far more than you could possibly realize.

Do you say the rosary? You can learn if you don't know how. And it only takes about 15-20 minutes. Rosarycenter.org has a great step by step guide with a diagram for you.

Each Hail Mary is a greeting and quite pleasing to her. Celebrate your mother this month! There is so much to learn about her, and she is very intriguing! What will you do to learn more about her? Watch the film *Fatima*? Stop by the parish library to see what we have? Begin to say the rosary?

St. Charles Apache Mission in San Carlos, including their clergy, staff, K-8 students and parents, wish to thank Our Lady of Joy parishioners for their very generous support of the Back-to-School drive in July. St. Charles school opened its doors in 1965, currently serves approximately 110 students, and is the only Catholic presence on the reservation.

Providing school supplies to the children goes beyond providing the tools they need to succeed. It directly impacts their confidence, classroom performance, and their families' financial stability. Students with their own supplies feel more prepared and independent. Having the right tools helps alleviate feelings of pressure associated with not being equipped like their peers. It also relieves parents of the "stress and worry" of budgeting several hundred dollars for supplies, which often must compete with basic needs like food, gas and rent. Donations allow teachers to begin instruction on the very first day without waiting for students to acquire materials. It also prevents teachers from having to pay for missing supplies out of their own pockets. Importantly, it also shows the St. Charles students that there is a wider world of people at Our Lady of Joy who care about their educational journey and future.

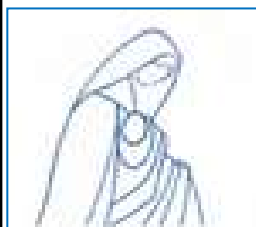

Apparition of Immaculate Mary

There are numerous apparition claims concerning the Blessed Virgin. However, there are only 16 apparitions validated by the Vatican.

The approved apparition for August is:

Our Lady of Knock August 21 (1879, Ireland)

Vignette: A silent apparition: Mary, St. Joseph, St John the Evangelist, and the Lamb on the altar--a vision of heavenly worship.

Inquiry: Commission of inquiry 1879; reaffirmed by later commissions; papal recognition by Pius XII (1936) and John Paul II (1979 visit).

Symbol: Lamb on altar

Prayer: *Queen of Ireland, draw us into the worship of the Lamb.*

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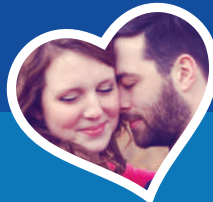
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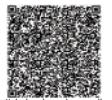
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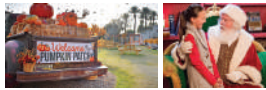
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
